OUR SCHOOL

John Barsby Community Secondary is situated on the traditional and unceded territory of the Snuneymuxw Nation. We are part of a neighborhood with long time residents and have strong ties and good commitment from community partners to support our students. As part of our space and place, the school is centrally located in the Harewood community and is in close proximity to the Chase River, Colliery Dam and Vancouver Island University.

The socio-economic diversity of our families is becoming as wide as the diversity of the students in our classrooms. Many of our students access our Food Mob through Loaves and Fishes, and our breakfast and lunch food equity program.

Of our 820 students; nearly 250 of our students identify as First Nations, Inuit or Metis. Approximately 45 International students visit us from a variety of countries around the world, some staying for a year and others staying to graduate. We also include a growing population of immigrants and refugees from Syria, Afghanistan, Ukraine and other countries, in our student body.
